Ordinance No. 2011-01

An Ordinance of the City of East Wenatchee removing certain provisions of East Wenatchee Municipal Code Chapter 2.36 relating to vacations, leaves, and holidays by repealing Ordinance 92-11, by repealing Ordinance 93-14, by amending title to Chapter 2.36, and by renumbering the remaining provision, containing a severability clause, and establishing an effective date.

1. Recitals

- a. Preamble. The City of East Wenatchee ("City") is a non-charter code City duly incorporated and operating under the laws of the State of Washington; and
- b. The City Council of East Wenatchee ("City Council") finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its citizens to remove the provisions regarding vacations, leaves, and holidays from the East Wenatchee Municipal Code.
- c. This Ordinance will remove provisions found in EWMC Chapter 2.36 that were enacted in 1992 and in 1993.
- d. Since 1993, the City has negotiated contracts with employees, collectively and individually, and has established a Manual of Personnel Policies and Procedures. In light of these other agreements and policies, the provisions of EWMC 2.36 are obsolete, inconsistent with current City policy, inconsistent with the terms of negotiated contracts, or duplicative.

2. Authority.

- a. RCW 35A.11.020 and RCW 35A.12.190 authorize the City Council to adopt ordinances of all kinds to regulate its municipal affairs and appropriate to the good government of the City.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST WENATCHEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to remove the provisions in EWMC Chapter 2.36 that relate to vacations, leaves, and holidays.

Section 2: Amendment. The City Council amends the title of Chapter 2.36 as follows:

Chapter 2.36

SHARED LEAVE VACATIONS, LEAVES AND HOLIDAYS

Section 3: Amendment. The City Council amends EPMC 2.36.090 by renumbering it as 2.36.010 and by amending the following language:

I. The Mayor ~~city administrator~~ shall monitor the use of shared leave to ensure consistent and nondiscriminatory treatment for all employees of the city. Inappropriate use or treatment of the shared leave program may result in the cancellation of the donated leave or use of shared leave.

Section 4: Repeal. The City Council repeals Ordinance 92-11.

Section 5: Repeal. The City Council repeals Ordinance 93-14.


Section 6: Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction declares any provision in this Ordinance to be contrary to law, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 7: Publication. The City Council directs the City Clerk to publish a summary of this Ordinance. The summary shall consist of the title of this Ordinance

Section 8: Effective Date. This Ordinance becomes effective five days after the date its summary is published.



Summary of Ordinance No. 2011-01
